


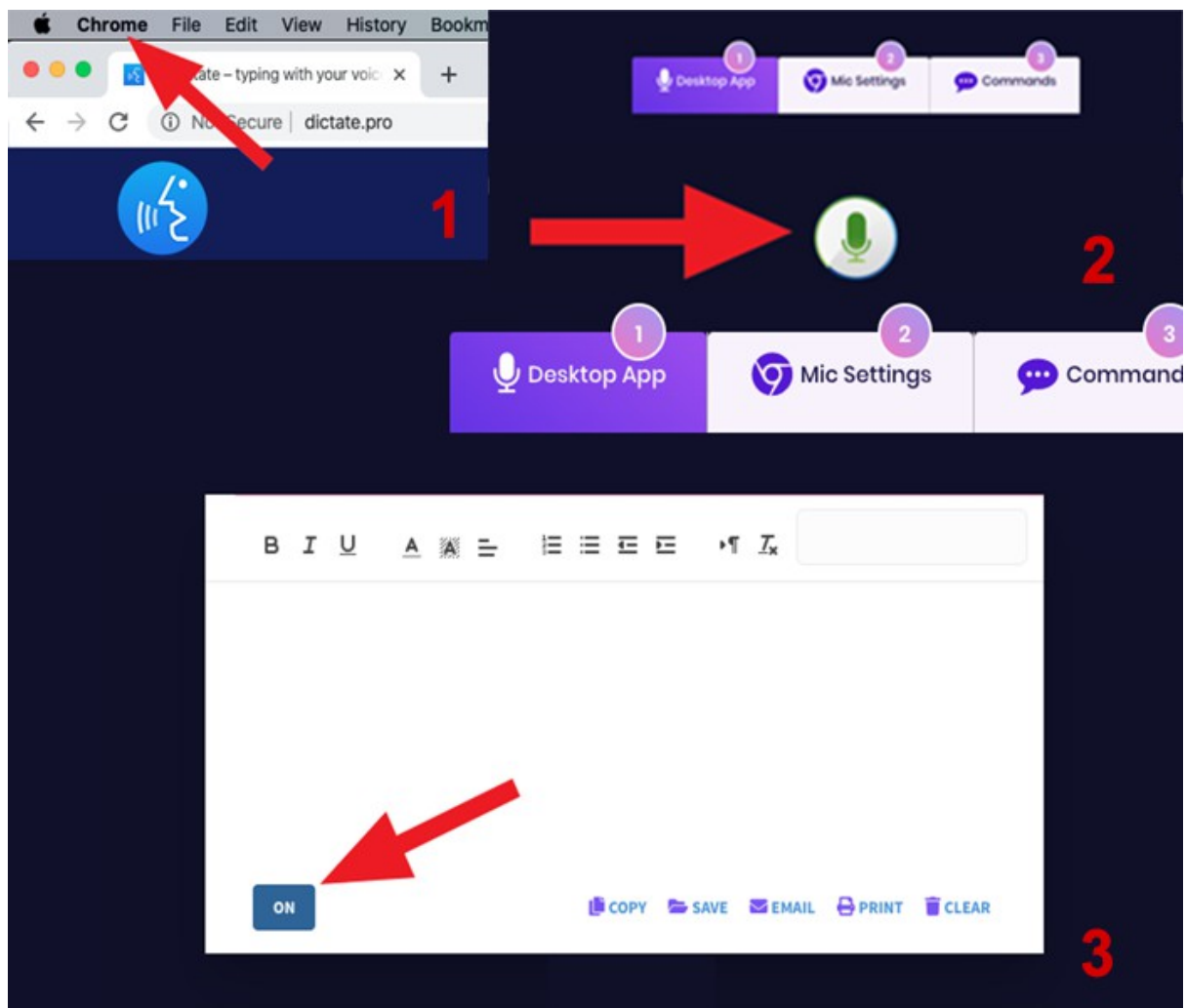


INSTRUCTIONS FOR MIC SETTINGS IN GOOGLE CHROME

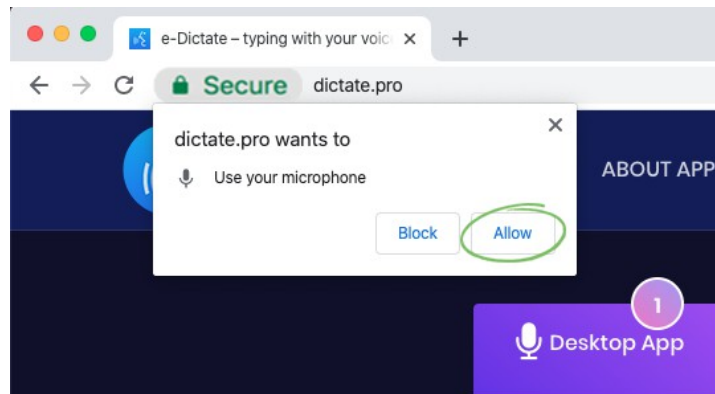
To dictate your text using the e-Dictate Web App, you need a Google Chrome browser on a computer running whit OS Windows, Mac OS X, or Linux. e-Dictate Web App is not available for smartphones, for smartphones use e-Dictate - Speech To Text & Translator which can be downloaded at the Google Play Store: <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=rs.edukom.diktat>

Settings the mic - step by step

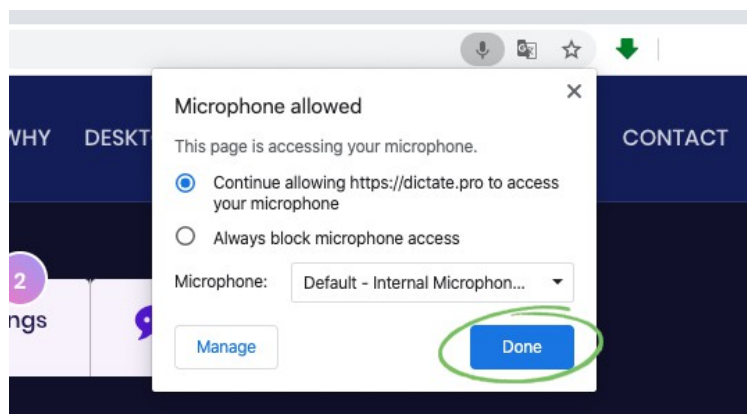
1. Load the <https://dictate.pro> site into **Google Chrome** 
2. Scroll to the e-Dictate Web App section and click the mic icon 
3. When the e-Dictate Web App is loaded, click the **ON** button. 



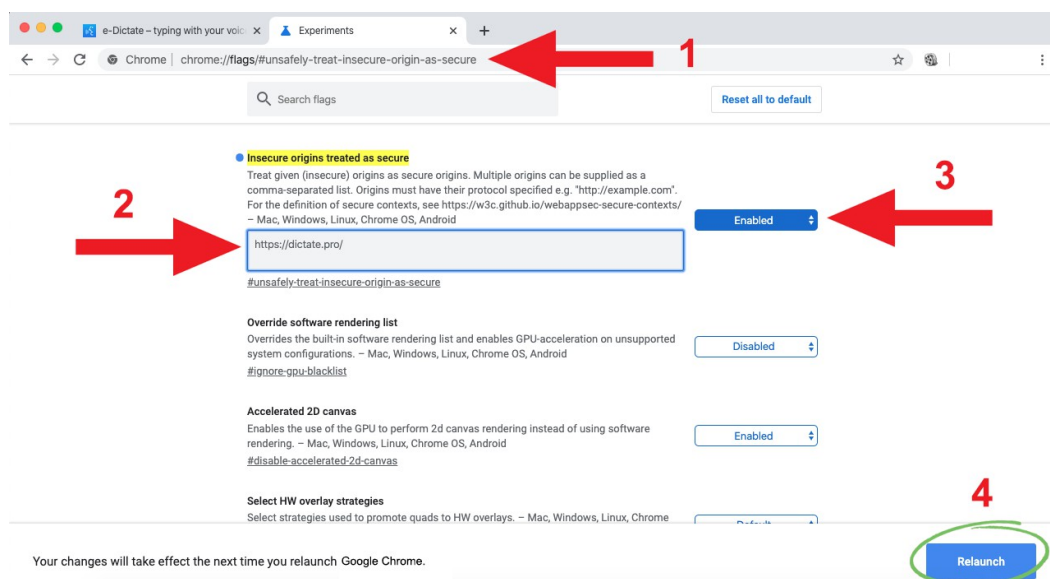
4. After clicking the ON button, a dialog "Use your microphone" will appear, you need to click **Allow** button.



5. After allow your mic, a mic icon will appear on the right side of the status bar. Click on the mic icon and confirm with the **DONE** button as in the picture.



A special variant for settings the mic



In some situations, it is not possible to allow the mic as in the previous instruction. That's why we've provided additional guidance for you on how to allow a mic. To ignore Chrome's secure origin policy, follow these steps.

First, in the Google Chrome address bar, copy the following URL:

<chrome://flags/#unsafely-treat-insecure-origin-as-secure>

after loading, in the "**Insecure origins treated as secure**" section add site:

Select **Enabled** and finally click **Relaunch**.
